Alcohol use during pregnancy can cause permanent brain damage called Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder.

People with FASD struggle throughout their lives with school, relationships, jobs...

...and often end up in the justice system.

Once there, the struggles continue.

Part of the reason is because a lot of times people with this disorder look just like everyone else.
